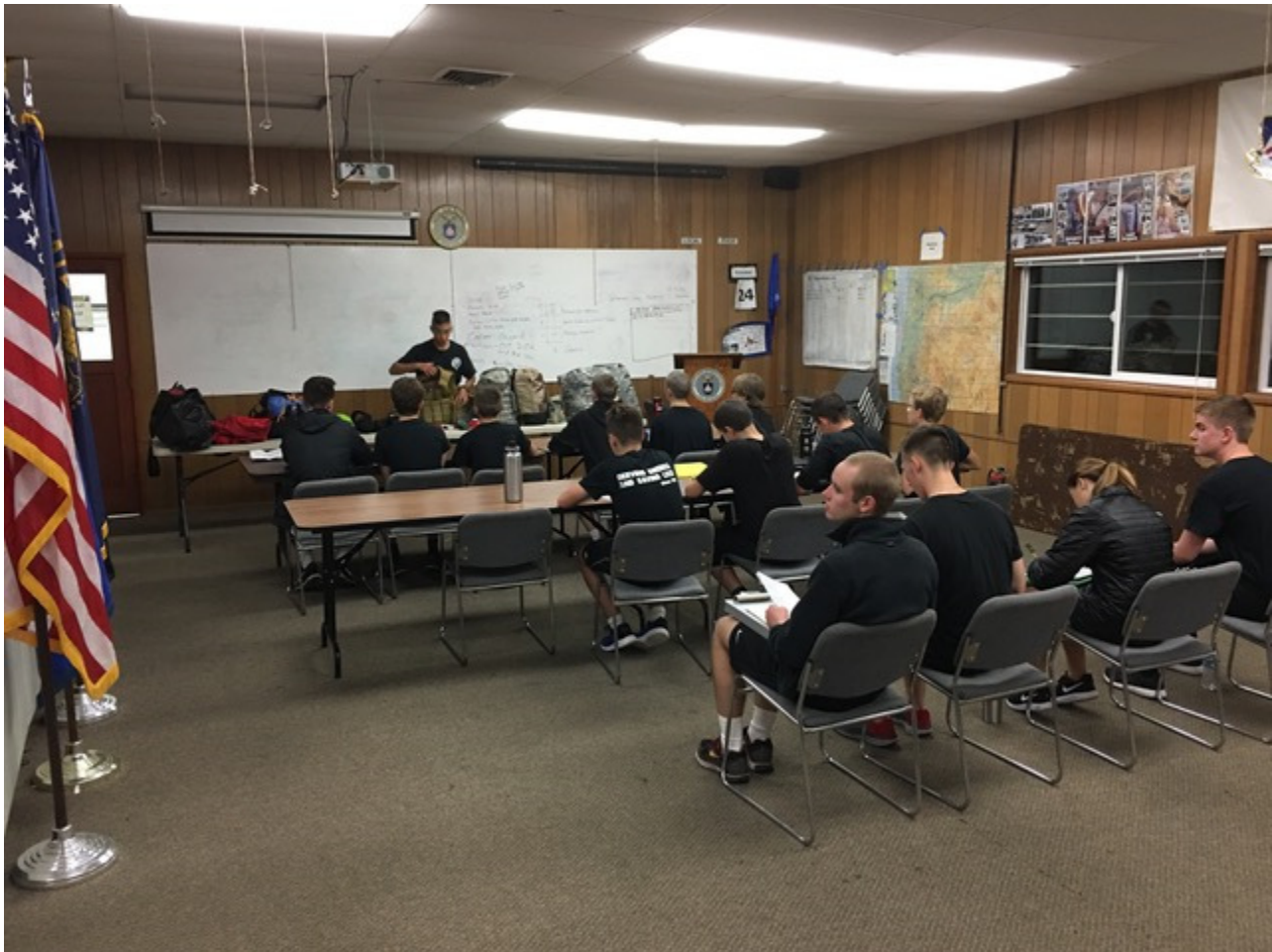

Cadet Magsarili shows the contents of his CAP Ground Team 24-hour emergency pack.

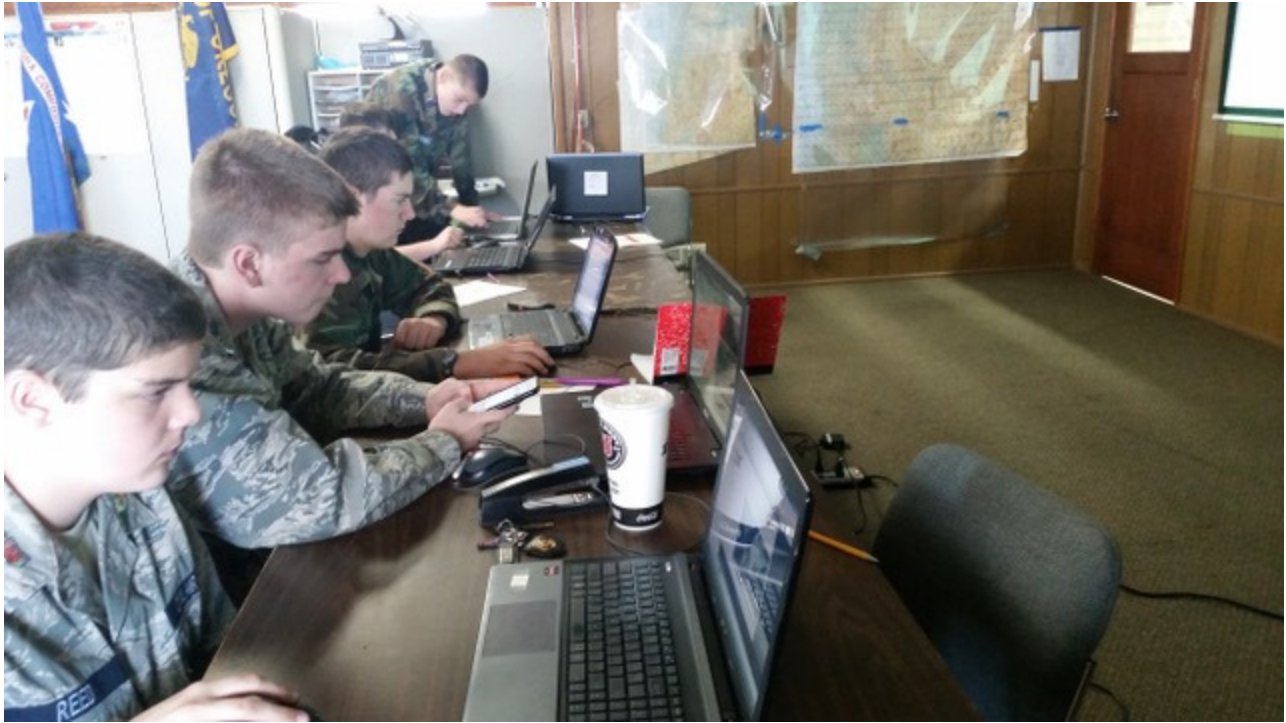


SM Farnsworth, who also volunteers with Mountain Wave Search and Rescue, discusses the contents of his emergency pack
