Cadets Jellison and M Van Sickle, together with Maj Knox, met at Mentor Graphics for the first competition round of the season.

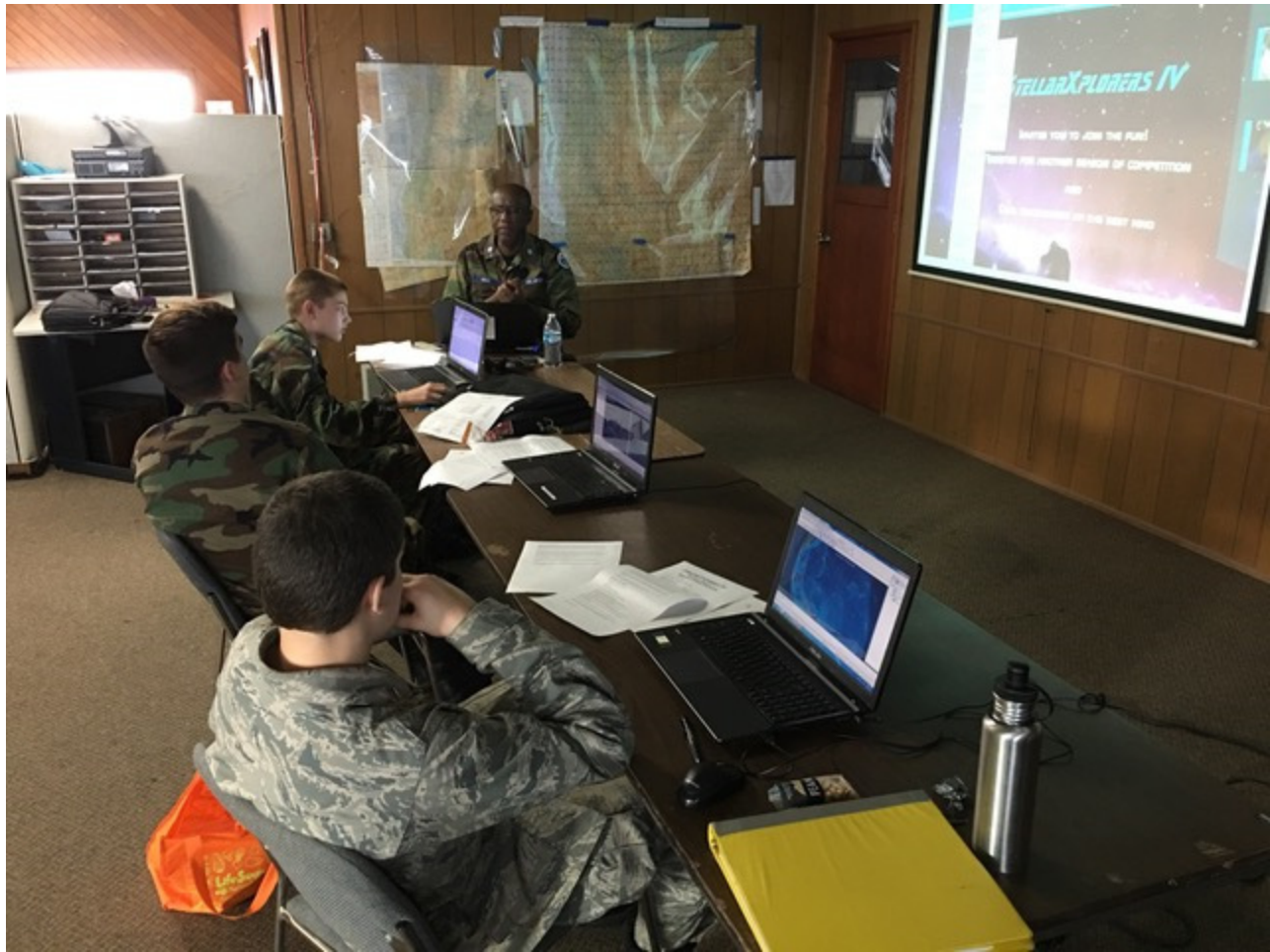
