Weekly Meeting

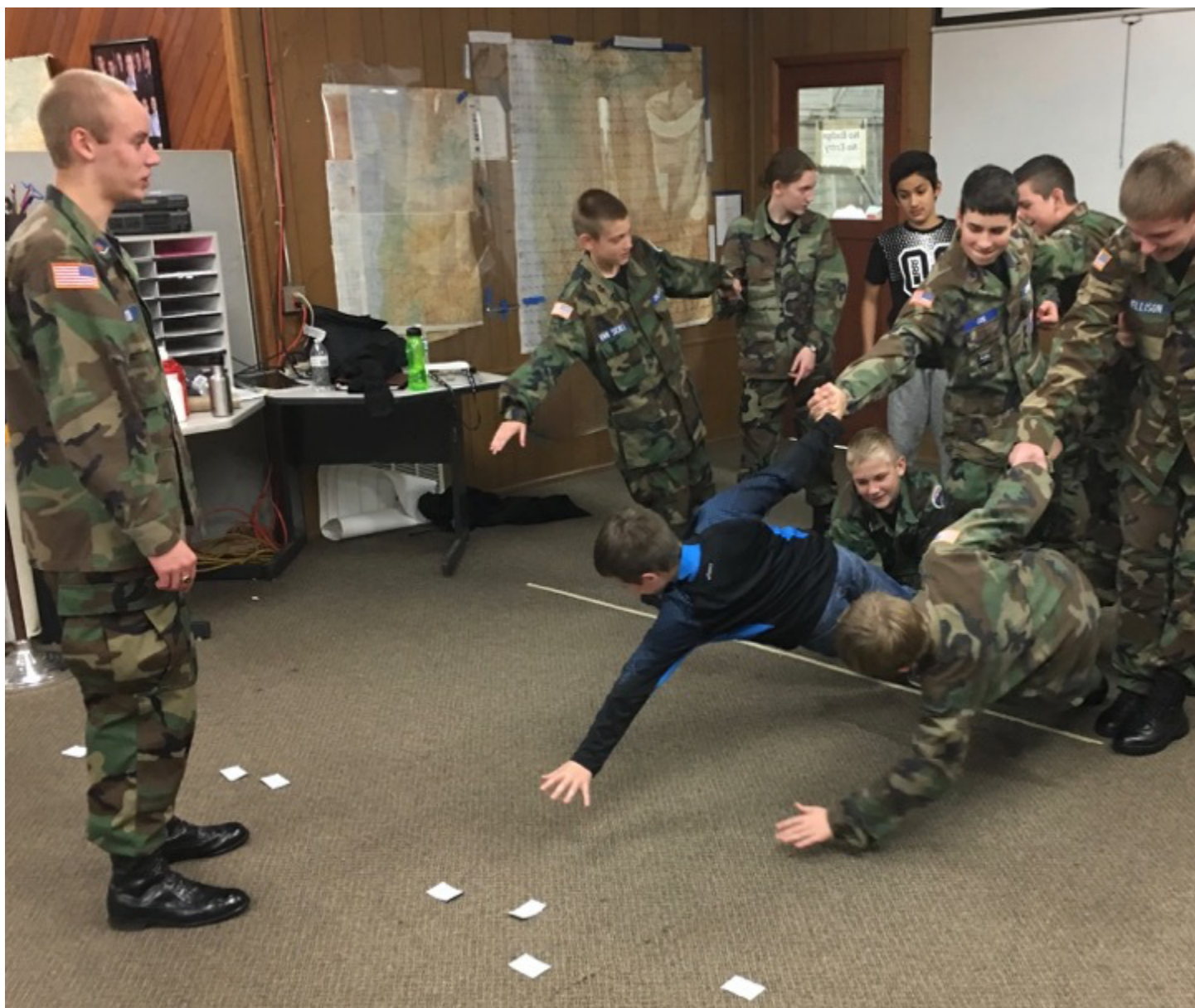
Tuesday, November 1
